December Schedule and Lunch Information

Monday, 12/13: Normal day. Your child may buy hot lunch.

Thursday 12/16 and Friday 12/17: Half-day for the entire school. Your child must have pre-ordered hot lunch.

On the 13th and 14th, our schedule is the same. We will have lunch at the same time etc. On those days, bus routes will be combined. Your child may ride a different route home - and may arrive home at a different time.

I have had several questions about lunch on half days. If your child has pre-ordered a hot lunch on the half days, they will be called to the lunchroom to eat before we leave to go home. If your child has not ordered lunch, they will not eat lunch at school.
